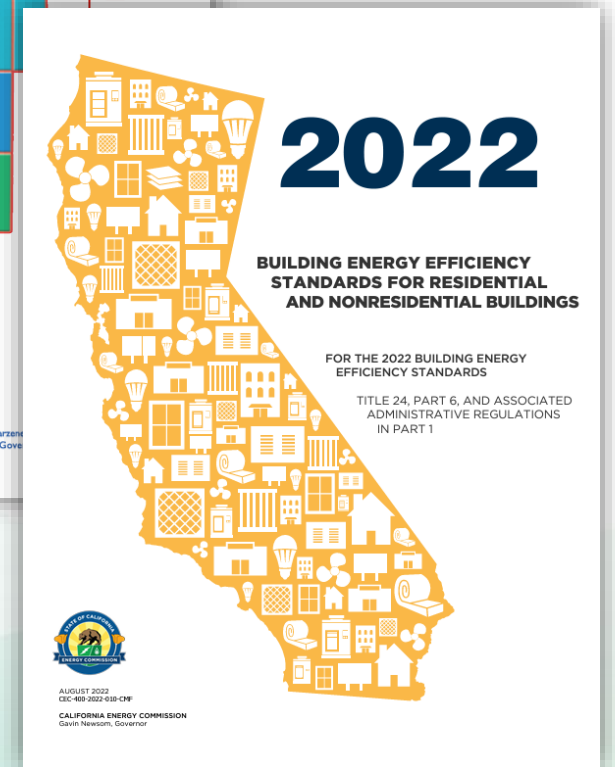
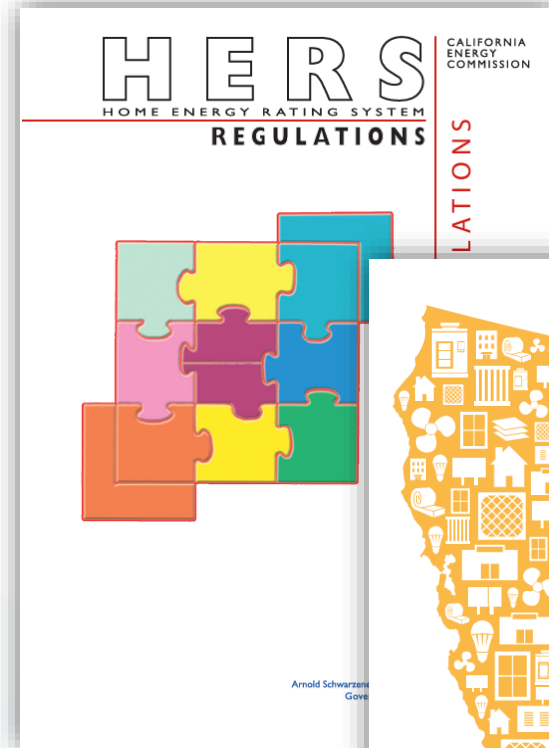
Home Energy Rating System Overview

HERS providers:

- Train and certify HERS raters
- Perform quality assurance of raters
- Respond to complaints
- Collect and maintain data

Residential data registries:

- Must be operated by a HERS provider
- Gather and validate user input data
- Generate official compliance documentation

Application Overview

- California Home Energy Efficiency Services (CHEERS)
 - A registration provider for single-family and nonresidential construction.
 - A Home Energy Rating System (HERS) program provider.
- CHEERS Application:
 - Requests approval to add multifamily projects to its registry.
