## **Benefits to California**



- Resiliency
- Reduces demand on electrical grid during peak demand
- Supports community as cooling stations during power outages and gathering locations during wildfires
- Fosters relationships and collaboration with California Native American tribes



## Tule River Indian Tribe of the Tule River Reservation, California



- Energy Conservation Assistance Act (ECAA) -\$2.2M loan at 1% interest
- Four photovoltaic arrays totaling 492 kW
- Paired battery energy storage systems
- \$150,000 yearly energy cost savings and 870,000 kWh annual grid use reduction
- Project layered with Department of Energy funding
- Supports existing electric vehicle charging infrastructure
