


- Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act of 2021 (IIJA)
- California, Oregon, and Washington jointly awarded \$102 million (one-time funding)
- California's share ~ \$60 million
- Public charging and fueling infrastructure along Alternative Fuel Corridors



Objectives:

- MDHD vehicle charging and hydrogen refueling stations in California, Oregon and Washington
- Install along I-5 in each state and key freight routes in California

- Formalizes partnership between CEC and Caltrans
- Makes CEC lead for developing and managing CFI funding opportunity and agreements





Benefits to Californians

- Supports MDHD ZEV transition
- Economic benefit to CA with federal funds
