BUILD Overview: Designed to Address Market Barriers

Authority & Governance

- Senate Bill 1477 (Stern, Chapter 378, Statutes of 2018)
- CPUC Decision 20-03-027
- BUILD Program Guidelines, First Edition, February 16, 2022

Eligible Projects

- New all-electric affordable housing
- Targets: Low-income and Disadvantaged Communities and California Native American Tribes
- Designed to provide bill savings for residents

Incentives

- Flexible to support the complicated financing and regulatory requirements of affordable housing
- Up to \$2,000,000 in incentives per developer
 - Based on the GHG avoided compared to a dual-fuel building
- 300 hours of technical assistance
- New Adopter incentive (up to \$100,000) to mitigate early upfront costs



Summary of Proposed BUILD Guidelines Revisions

1. Increase Participation: Expand developer eligibility requirements to accommodate combined developer experience

2. Accommodate Projects: Expand options to program's "utility cost savings requirements" to allow projects that do not have virtual net energy metering

3. Ensure Accuracy: Simplify approaches to the BUILD incentive calculation to strengthen accuracy

4. Update Equipment Lists: Align with 2022 Energy Code and current industry trends
