Commissioner Hochschild received an invitation to participate in the seventh edition of the World Forum on Energy Regulation as a special guest and speaker from the Chair of Mexico's Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE), who is also the Chairman of the Forum. The Commissioner will be speaking during a session on the implementation of decarbonization policies.
