



Overview

Commercially available electrification and decarbonization measures

- Evaluate non-energy impacts on residents
- 100 single-family homes in Ventura, San Luis Obispo, and Santa Barbara counties
 - Majority in justice communities, including homes near Ormond Beach power station
- Evaluate residents' experiences and perceptions of the retrofitting process
