NASEO is the national non-profit association (501(c)(3)) for the governor-designated energy officials from each of the 56 states and territories. Formed by the states in 1986, NASEO facilitates peer learning among state energy officials, serves as a resource for and about State Energy Offices, and advocates for the interests of the State Energy Offices to Congress and federal agencies.

NASEO provided travel stipend to cover the travel costs of state energy officials, who attended its free training on Integrated Distribution Planning.
