* These values include a substantial amount of labor used to access and replace the HVAC equipment which includes; project management, closing street permits and crane services.

** The simple payback is based on the loan amount divided by annual cost savings.

*** EUL considered for 1% loans will be lesser of actual EUL or 17 Years.

The Energy Commission staff has determined that the City of Placerville loan application is technically feasible and meets the requirements for an ECAA one percent loan and has a simple payback of 13.1 years. EULs will be the lesser of the EUL stated in the application or 17 years to allow for repayment of principal and interest within 20 years.

The borrower shall implement only measures listed in Table 1. If borrower does not complete the measures or deviates from the quantities and specifications listed in Table 1, a letter of agreement or loan amendment may be necessary to document these changes, at the discretion of the Energy Commission.

If the borrower has received disbursements exceeding the maximum loan amount supported by the project, the borrower shall refund the difference to the Energy Commission within 30 days of notification.

RESOLVED, that the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (Energy Commission) adopts the staff CEQA findings contained in the Agreement or Amendment Request Form (as applicable); and

RESOLVED, that the Energy Commission approves Agreement 003-18-ECD with City of Placerville for \$784,112 loan for seven energy measures including replacement of interior and exterior lighting, lighting controls, and HVAC units with more energy efficient units, and adopting staff's determination that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The project is estimated to save the city 320,835.53 kWh of electricity, resulting in annual energy cost savings of \$60,017. The simple combined average payback on the loan amount is approximately 13.1 years and meets the 17 years; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director or his/her designee shall execute the same on behalf of the Energy Commission.
