#### **REACH 3.0 Benefits to Californians**

- Affordable, reliable, and conveniently accessible charging for multi-family housing residents
- Increased availability of EV charging
- Reduce vehicle emissions in low-income communities, disadvantaged communities, and for affordable housing residents
- Improve EV education and awareness to encourage EV adoption by multifamily housing residents



## **Ecology Action Project Overview**
