

Commissioner Andrew McAllister has been invited to attend a conference focusing on the development of policies that support building electrification and natural gas infrastructure reduction, with emphasis on supporting cities and states that have already undertaken efforts. The event is sponsored by the Rockefeller Brothers Fund and will take place at the Pocantico Center in Tarrytown, New York. Subnational leaders, non-profit organizations, and other thought leaders have been invited to participate in working sessions that seek to design strategies for, and identify challenges to, clean energy policy implementation. Commissioner McAllister is one of California's leading experts on building electrification and will play an essential role in sharing California's recent developments in building energy efficiency codes and other state energy policy issues.
