R) Justification of Rates

Sponsorship rates are based on the fact that California is very large and very expensive to survey. California's solar market is the largest in the country and its workforce represents nearly 30 percent of the entire U.S. solar jobs market. Thus, this 2019 pricing is more commensurate with the level of effort required to produce statistically significant data points at the granular level for such an enormous state. The California Energy Commission's sponsorship does not come close to covering the full costs for California, but the California Energy Commission's contribution helps to fill the funding gap that remains and ensures that The Solar Foundation's highest quality numbers are used by California leaders in understanding market drivers and potential for an important growing sector of the economy.
