The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission consists of five members, nominated by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Supervisors. Their responsibility is to provide operational oversight in areas such as rates and charges for services, approval of contracts, and organizational policy.

3.2. Payment Description: Provide a specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Chair Hochschild and Raja Ramesh attended a tour of the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System, at the invitation of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC). This was an opportunity to network with a select group of Congressional and California legislative staff and SFPUC leadership while learning about this important regional asset that delivers water and power to 2.7 million Bay Area residents and businesses. This tour offered a behind-the-scenes look at the regional water and power system, including Moccasin Powerhouse, which generates greenhouse gas-free hydroelectricity, and ended at Hetch Hetchy Reservoir in Yosemite National Park. SFPUC provided transportation, meals, and overnight lodging at the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir in one of three SFPUC-owned cabins.
