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# Energy Security Plan Status

## Background

- 2021 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act required states to develop an Energy Security Plan addressing six mandated elements
- Requirements in effect through October 2025

## Status

- September 2025 CEC submitted the approved version to DOE
- Public version posted to the CEC website

- Ensures funding under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act
- Supports risk reduction, long-term resilience, economic & public safety for Californians
