**2. Donor Name and Address:** SCPPA is a Joint Powers Authority, created in 1980, to provide joint planning, financing, construction, and operation of transmission and generation projects. Comprised of eleven municipal utilities and one irrigation district, SCPPA's members serve more than 5 million Californians (2 million customers) across a service area of 9,000 square miles. SCPPA members supply 16% of California's power.

**3.1 (a) Travel Payment:** Transportation providers were Charter UP Bus and Southwest Airlines. Lodging facilities were Roosevelt Hollywood & Mission Inn Riverside.

**3.2. Payment Description:** This is the Southern California Public Power Authority's 2025 Policy Staff Tour, where government agency staff are invited to tour and learn about generation facilities and other resources that are critical to California's system reliability and clean energy goals.

The Energy Assessments Division (EAD) has a statutory requirement to assess publicly owned utility resource plans. Additionally, CEC leadership has requested EAD to increase engagement with balancing authorities and publicly owned utilities to understand resource challenges in California to inform policy. This trip enabled EAD leadership to gain a better understanding of challenges and opportunities faced by POU that should be considered in broader state energy planning, such as SB 100 and integrated resource planning activities.

As Chief of Staff and Chief Policy Advisor for the Vice Chair, Jane and Raja play a critical role in facilitating and developing relationships with POU executive leadership on behalf of the Commissioner. It is crucial for them to engage with POU and understand their operational and policy needs to establish partnerships between CEC and POU leaders.
