Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

The National Association of State Energy Officials (NASEO) is the only national non-profit association for the governor-designated energy officials from each of the 56 states and territories. Formed by the states in 1986, NASEO facilitates peer learning among state energy officials, serves as a resource for and about State Energy Offices, and advocates for the interests of the State Energy Offices to Congress and federal agencies.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Commissioner Andrew McAllister represents California on the Executive Committee as the former chair of the NASEO Board of Directors (Board). Energy offices of all member states and territories will meet and confer with each other, the federal government and other stakeholders on the implementation of key initiatives. Participation will allow the CEC to anticipate future federal actions and build relationships with key officials essential to protecting the state's energy interests.
