To facilitate cross-Pacific dialogue and collaboration that advances climate solutions.

3.2. Payment Description:

The Inaugural Pacific Climate Summit, convened by Pacific Civic Exchange, is designed as a high-level forum where Pacific nations and climate leaders coordinate strategies on climate resilience, ocean governance, emissions reduction, and regional security. California is legally and strategically obligated to advance these issues under its statutory climate-reduction framework, including the Global Warming Solutions Act (AB 32) and subsequent legislative mandates requiring statewide emissions reductions, climate adaptation planning, and international climate cooperation. Chair Hochschild's in-person presence ensures California fulfills its statutory and executive obligations to lead, collaborate, and support climate-vulnerable regions while advancing the state's clean-energy, climate-finance, and adaptation priorities in a forum uniquely aligned with those legal directives.
