2. Entity's Business Activity:

The National Association of State Energy Officials (NASEO) is the only national nonprofit organization representing the governor-designated energy directors and their offices – the State Energy Offices – from the 56 States and Territories across the nation. Formed by the states in 1986, NASEO facilitates sharing of best practices among states, serves as a technical and policy resource for states, and advocates the interests of State Energy Offices to Congress and federal agencies.

3.2. Payment Description:

Peter Chen has been invited to attend the National Association of State Energy Officials (NASEO) 2026 State Transportation Energy Summit in Arlington, VA. This two-day event will convene State Energy Offices working at the nexus of energy and transportation with public and private sector partners to discuss emerging transportation energy needs and priority opportunities. NASEO requested Peter to moderate a session on "Second Life EV Batteries as Affordable Grid Assets: From Theory to Reality" as well as highlight how CEC is supporting second-life applications of EV batteries and other research and development opportunities to support the re-use of EV batteries. Other sessions at the Summit will cover key priorities for the Electric Program Investment Charge (EPIC) including proactive planning for transportation electrification, streamlining interconnection, medium- and heavy-duty charging hubs, and harnessing electric vehicles as a grid resource. The Summit will facilitate knowledge exchange on these topics, clearer understanding of actions underway across state energy offices, and inform implementation of the EPIC program going forward.
