The [California Energy Commission](#) established a Petroleum Market Advisory Committee to better understand factors and conditions related to petroleum price fluctuations, the impacts on consumers, and policy options that may affect markets.

The committee consists of five petroleum fuels market experts appointed to the committee by the Energy Commission. These leading energy economists and experts will provide the Energy Commission and state regulators with independent advice and insights on issues affecting the market, from local policies to global events.
