Grant Solicitation GFO-21-601

Charging Access for Reliable On-Demand Transportation Services (CARTS) February 14, 2022

On August 31, 2021, the California Energy Commission (CEC) released a Grant Solicitation and Application Package entitled “Charging Access for Reliable On-Demand Transportation Services (CARTS)” under the Clean Transportation Program. This grant solicitation was to fund projects that would support electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure for high mileage on-demand transportation services including services such as ride-hailing, taxis, and meal or grocery delivery. The Clean Transportation Program funding was available to fund applications in three regions: Northern California, Central Valley, and Southern California.

The grant solicitation announced a total of \$6 million available for the agreement(s) resulting from this solicitation. In accordance with the solicitation, the CEC, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to increase or reduce the amount of funds available.

The attached table, “GFO-21-601 NOPA Results Table”, identifies each applicant selected and recommended for funding by CEC staff and includes the amount of recommended funding and score.

Funding of proposed projects resulting from this solicitation is contingent upon the approval of these projects at a publicly noticed CEC Business Meeting and execution of a grant agreement. The CEC reserves the right to negotiate with applicants to modify the project scope, the level of funding, or both. If the CEC is unable to successfully negotiate and execute a funding agreement with an applicant, the CEC, at its sole discretion and in addition to all of its other rights, reserves the right to cancel the pending award and fund the next eligible application.
