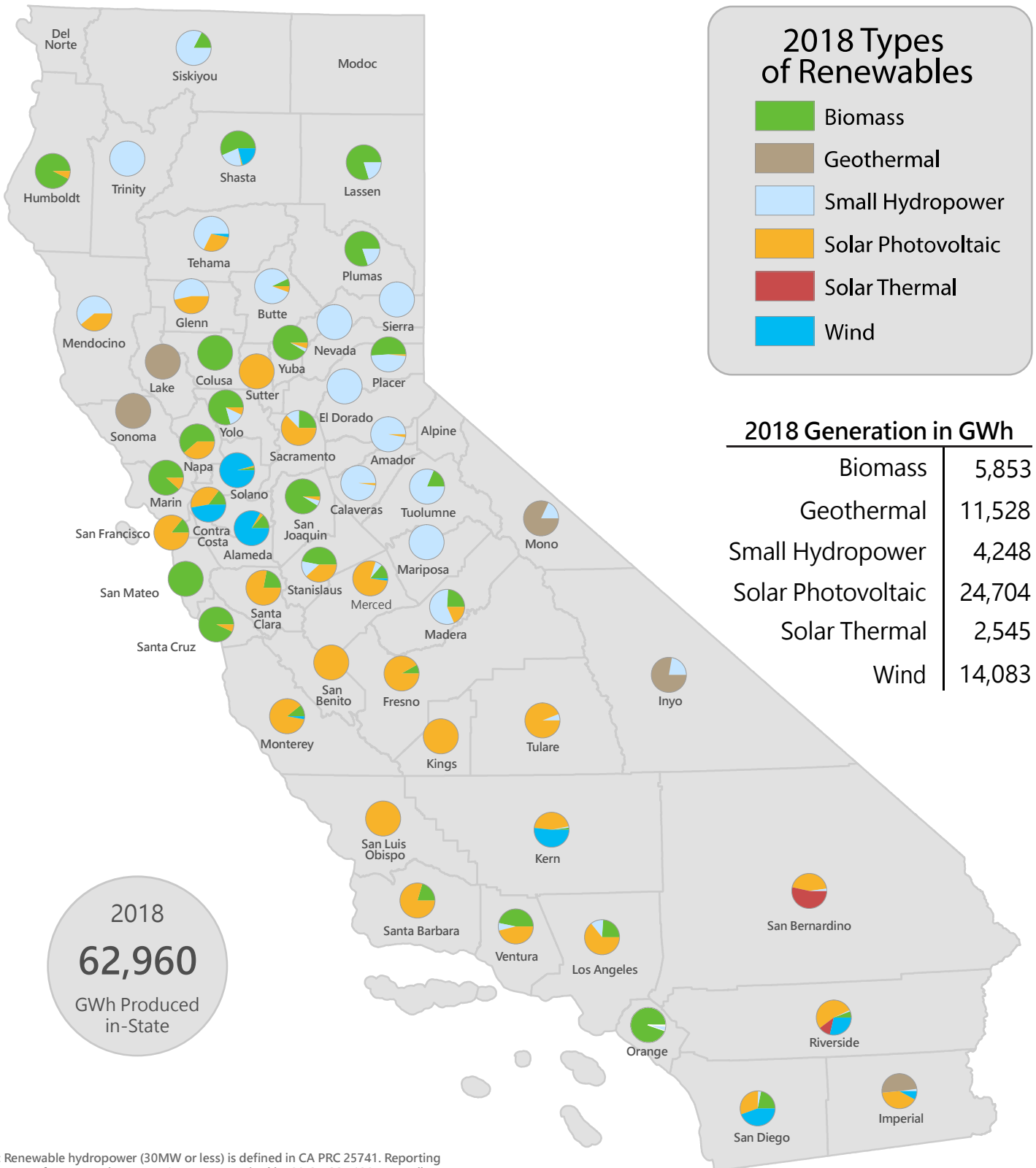


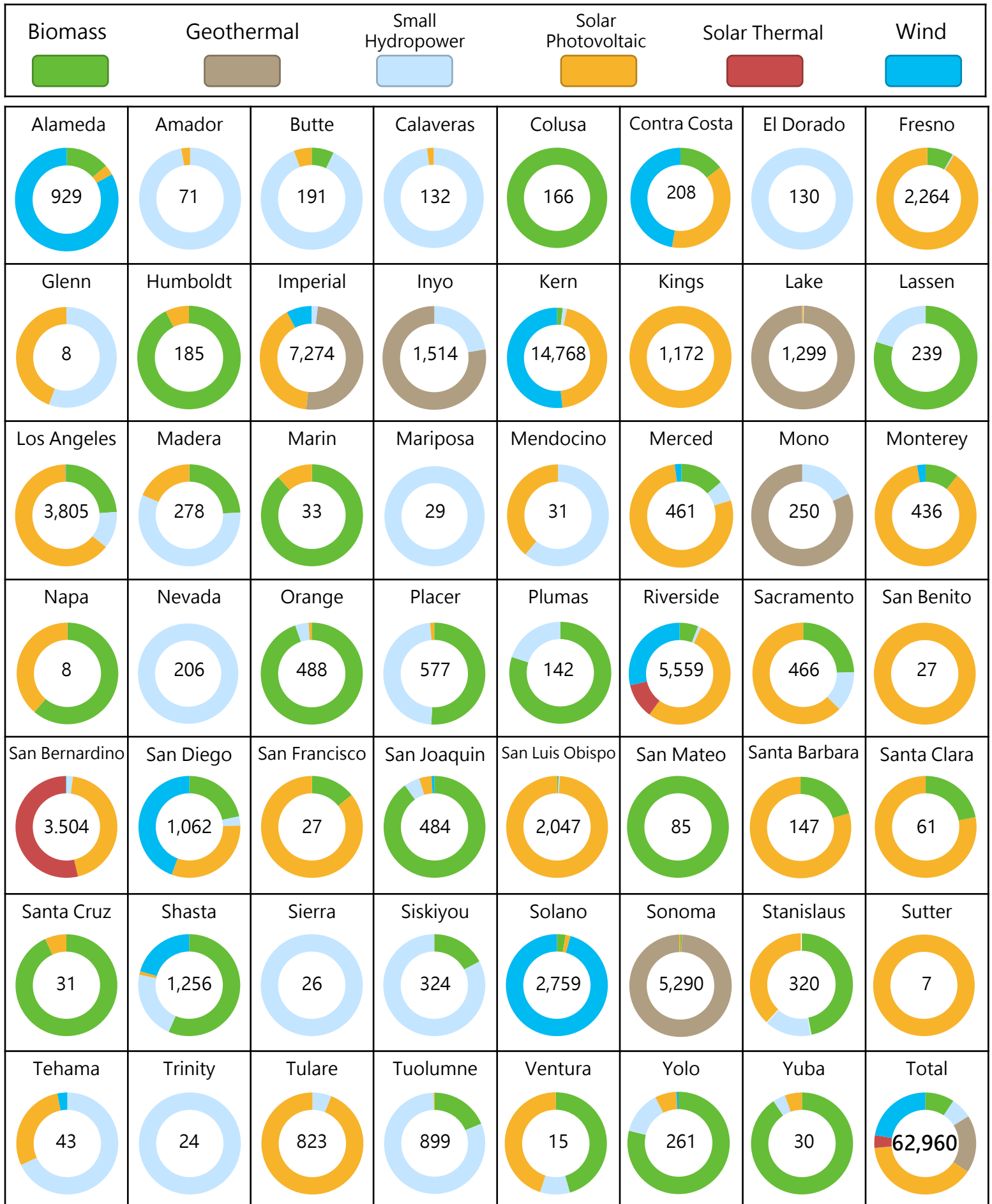
Utility-Scale Renewable Electrical Generation Types by County
