The California Energy Commission administers the California Schools Healthy Air, Plumbing, and Efficiency (CalSHAPE) Program. The CalSHAPE Online System is the online application and reporting system for the CalSHAPE Program. This system is employed by local educational agencies (LEA) and state agencies to submit applications and final reporting packages for the two CalSHAPE grant programs: CalSHAPE Ventilation Program and CalSHAPE Plumbing Program.

Applicants may use the CalSHAPE Plumbing Program Application Checklist to verify that the application and contractor estimate meet CalSHAPE Program requirements.

This application checklist document is provided for informational purposes only to assist users with completing the application. It does not include all CalSHAPE Plumbing Program information or requirements.
