



## **Finding the Building Reference Number**

- 1. Visit benchmarkingca.com.
- **2.** Search for the building's street address in the "Street" field.



- **3.** In the populated table, find the building street address in the column titled "Street."
- **4.** The Benchmarking Reference Number is in the first column on the left titled "BRN / LOCAL JURISDICTION ID."



## Add the Benchmarking Reference Number to ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager

- Log in to <u>ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager</u>.
  From your Dashboard, click on a property to add its Benchmarking Reference Number.
- 2. Select the "Details" tab.



**3.** Scroll down to the middle of the edit page and select edit in the "Unique Identifiers (IDs)" box.



- **4.** Scroll down to the "Standard IDs" box. In the State/Province drop-down box, select "California Building ID."
- **5.** Type your Benchmarking Reference Number in the field on the right.



- **6.** Scroll to the bottom and click "Save."
- 7. After you have saved the Benchmarking Reference Number, you will need to resubmit your data to the CEC.
- **8.** To resubmit, please select the appropriate reporting link below:
  - a. Use this link to report 2024 energy use data.
  - b. <u>Use this link to report 2024 energy use data</u> and optional water use data.
- **9.** Follow the instructions on the page to resubmit your data to the CEC.
- You will receive a receipt email immediately following your submission and a confirmation email the next morning.

If you are required to report to an <u>exempted</u> <u>local benchmarking program</u>, you do not report to the CEC and the benchmarking reference number is not required.

**NOTE:** If you are required to report to an <u>exempted local</u> <u>benchmarking program</u>, you do not report to the CEC and the benchmarking reference number is not required.
