➤ New Submission Process

 Log into the DSP, select QFER consumption app, upload, pass validation, and review



➤ Note: Reporting requirements remain the same. Main differences are the submission tool, and the type of file and formatting accepted (e.g. CSV, <u>not</u> Excel)

- Template above is for Schedule 1 only. As before, ALL electric utilities are required to submit Schedule 1.
- Updated formatting/validations:
 - Valid values for Customer Type (uppercase letter): B (Bundled), D (Direct Access), C (Community Choice Aggregator), O (for BART, PGE only)
 - Rate Class is a required field only for UDCs with annual average peak demand 200 MW or higher in past two years.
 - NAICS Code must be valid, six-digits.

- Only electric utilities whose annual peak demand in the last two years is 200 MW or greater are required to submit Schedule 2. This is the same as before.
- Updated formatting/validations:
 - Quarter Number must be an integer value (i.e., 1, 2, 3, or 4)

- Updated formatting/validations:
 - Valid values for Customer Group (spelled exactly):
 Residential, Commercial, Industrial, TEOR, UEG, Other




Formatting Rules



Formatting Rules (1/3)

#1 File type must be comma separated values (CSV)... NOT Excel like before



#2 Must have the correct field order (i.e. must follow the CSV templates **exactly**)






Formatting Rules (2/3)

#3 Extra information such as headers, calculations/formulas, macros, and notes will not be accepted.

Example, headers:



#4 Do not include commas anywhere in the file. Do not have blank cells or non-numeric characters in the Company Number, Year, Month, County Number, Customer Count, Sales, and Revenue fields.

#5 Extra rows will <u>not</u> be accepted; only include required info

- Step 6: Attestation and complete submission






Step 3: Entity and Reporting Period (1/2)








Step 3: Entity and Reporting Period (2/2)









- Data dictionary showing expected data types and lists of valid values for fields that have common errors (e.g., NAICS code, county number, customer type, UDC name, etc.). Available in July 2025
